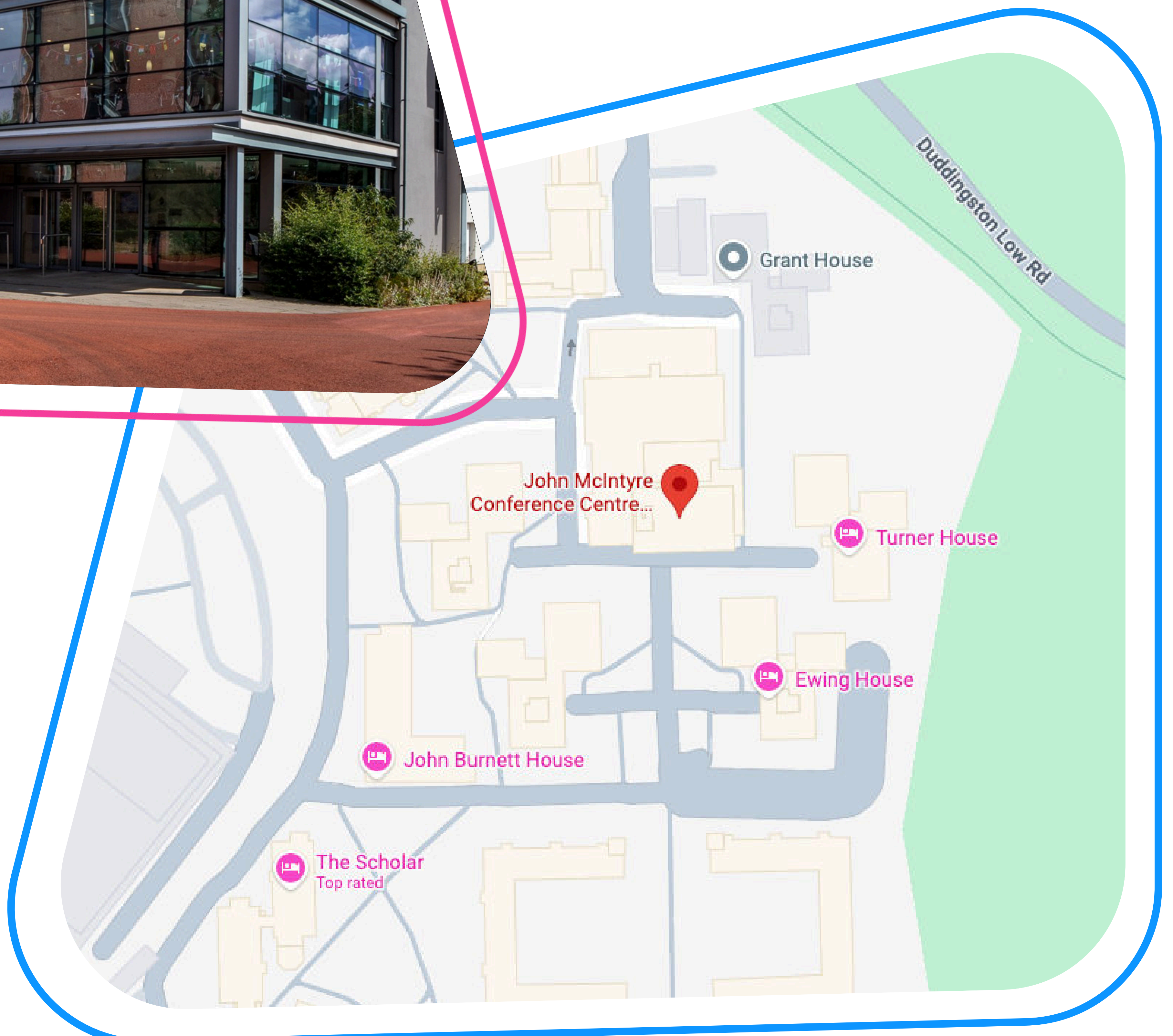

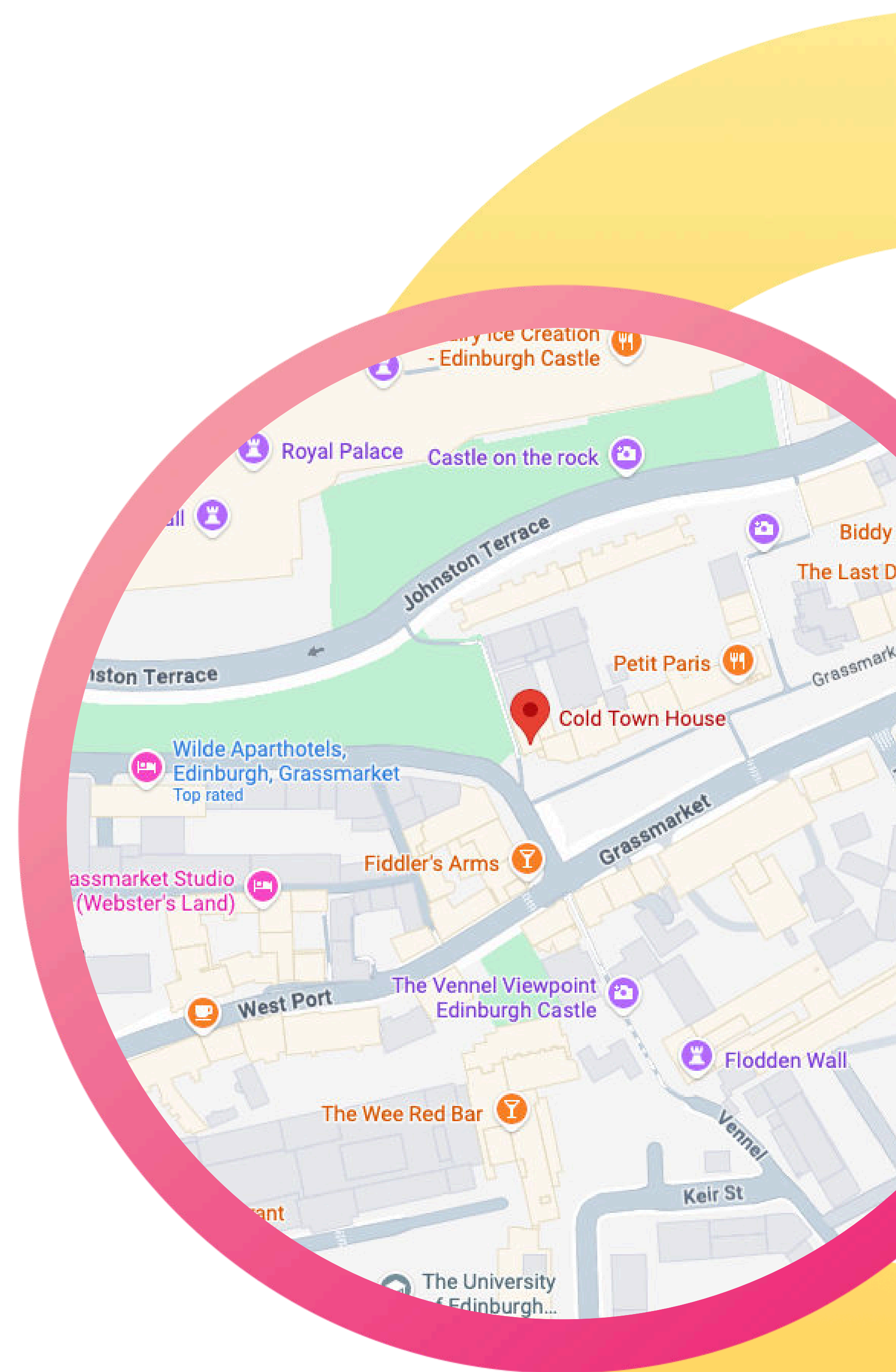
Meeting Point: Outside Cold Town House, 4 Grassmarket, Edinburgh EH1 2JU
